Relevance:

Accident & Similar - Notification of Victim Accident Information to (a pre-designated)

Contact Person(s) - via Information pre-stored in Victim's Mobile Telephone / Smartphone etc. Memory



'ICE' (In Case of Emergency)

'ICE' is a method of contact which might be used during emergency and / or accident situations. It assumes ownership and carriage of an appropriate mobile (cell) phone or similar (mobile) telecommunications device. It works as follows:

The details should be stored in your mobile phone's memory ('phonebook' or similar) under the name 'ICE'. For more than one contact simply enter under headings 'ICE 1', 'ICE 2', 'ICE 3' etc.

Consider telling your family, other relatives, friends and colleagues about the above so that they can consider using the ICE scheme also
